What have we achieved so far?

A **collection** of 12 exercises on 3D printing, 3D scanning, and CNC, plus 3 newly developed exercises, with downloadable templates and materials, ready to use

In each country, an activity is also conducted with students, **"Students' projects"**. Working in groups, the participants explore the exercises and implement them on their own to assess their usefulness and provide feedback to the consortium. A final internal report is prepared with the conclusions.
